

JUDGE SELECTION BALLOT 2027
Deadline August 7, 2026

The number of judges at the National Master Hunt Test Stake will be three.

Each judge must have qualified a dog at least five (5) times in CKC Master Hunt Tests and/or CKC Owner Handler Master Hunt Tests and must have judged at least 6 CKC or AKC Master Hunt Test Stakes.

Member Clubs will nominate a qualified and willing judge from their zone to judge the National Master Hunt Test Stake for the following year. Clubs within each zone should consult and attempt to reach a consensus on the nomination of one or two individuals from the zone. In the case of more than one nomination from a zone, the decision of the Executive will prevail. Judges for the following year's National stake will be selected at or before the Annual General Meeting one year prior to the event.

A judge will not be selected from Zone 3 as the 2027 National Master Hunt Test Stake is being hosted by Saskatoon Retriever Club.

Note: No more than one of the three judges for the National Master Hunt Test stake should be serving as a Director or on the executive of the Canadian National Master Retriever Club at the time of the event.

Upon accepting the judging assignment, judges for the National Master Hunt Test Stake will be required to sign a copy of the "National Master Hunt Test Stake: Philosophy and Judging Guidelines" document, agreeing to follow the guidelines as outlined. A copy will also be provided to the host Club.
